Thursday 25th January 7.30 pm.

Session One: Living with openness to God

Looks at what it means to live with openness to God and to the world.

Thursday 8th February 7.30 pm

Session Two: Thirsting for what is right

What does it mean to live with obedience to God and with a desire to put things right in the world?

(We will not be meeting in Lent as we will be doing the York Lent Course On Thursdays)

Thursday 12th April 7.30 pm.

Session Three: Living transparently

Exploring what it means to be transparent in all we do and are, this session looks at how we show others the mercy God gives to us.

Thursday 26th April 7.30 pm

Session Four: Peace-making

What does it mean to be a peacemaker after the example of Christ and what is the cost of this witness?

Thursday 10th May 7.30 pm

Session Five: Living as Citizens of God's Kingdom

Looks at what Jesus meant by the kingdom and how we can live as its citizens.

Thursday 24th May 7.30 pm

Session Six: Foundations

Explores what it means to build our lives on the teaching and example of Jesus, as we have seen in the beatitudes.

Dear Friends,

The Pilgrim Course is a course run all over the country by churches of all shapes and sizes. It gives an introduction to the Christian Faith and then gives those taking part an opportunity to ask any questions they might have.

The course is run over 8 modules, the first three of which—Turning to Christ the Lord's Prayer and the Ten Commandments—St. Andrew's has already done as a full course, and also as a church on the first Sunday of the Month. The fourth module is on "The Beatitudes", and teaches us about how Christians should build their lives on the teachings of Jesus.

The Course will take place fortnightly in The Choir Vestry, St. Andrew's Church, Melbourne Avenue, Chelmsford CM1 2DT. (Please use the Church Hall Car Park and enter the Church by the side door) on Thursday Evenings at 7.30 pm. The meetings will finish by 9.00 pm The course dates are described on the facing page.

The format of the course is for people to sit down together and have coffee or tea and then listen to a some input from a DVD introducing the subject. Then there is an opportunity to discuss what you have heard in groups. It is informal, relaxed, and gives an opportunity to ask any question about the Christian faith and so everyone's contribution will be listened to and valued.

I would like to encourage all of the congregation from St. Andrew's, Chelmsford to attend, and also to extend an invitation to anyone else who is interested.
